This plan summary reflects the content of the toxic substance reduction plan for Eston Manufacturing a Division of Linamar Holdings Inc. for Zinc.

Statement of Intent

Eston Manufacturing a Division of Linamar Holdings Inc. (Eston) is committed to playing a leadership role in protecting the environment. Whenever feasible, we will reduce the use of Zinc in compliance with all Federal and Provincial Regulations.

Objectives

Eston prides itself on technological innovation in order to produce high quality automotive parts in an environmentally responsible manner. Through this plan, Eston will determine the technical and economic feasibility of each option to determine which, if any, are viable for implementation at this time.

Reduction Options to be implemented

The following options have been identified for implementation to reduce the use and/or amount of Zinc transferred:

- Work with suppliers to reduce foundry defects received
- Implement training practices/procedures amongst machine operators to reduce scrap materials

Work with suppliers to reduce foundry defects received.

This option is an on-going procedure at Eston, with annual reduction targets that will change from year to year. The schedule for this reduction option is given below:
